About This Programme

Yongqing Fang is a **living heritage district** in Guangzhou — — where traditional craftsmanship, Cantonese opera, and local daily life continue to thrive side by side.

This half-day programme is designed for students to:

- **Walk through living history** – explore restored Qing-era alleyways, and discover how "micro-renovation" preserves heritage while breathing new life into the community
- **Meet the artisans** – step into working studios where masters of Cantonese embroidery, porcelain painting, and traditional biscuit mould carving practice their crafts daily
- **Get hands-on** – try a heritage craft yourself and take home what you make
- **Experience Cantonese opera** – visit the beautifully landscaped Cantonese Opera Art Museum (live performance if available)





Itinerary

Time	Activity & Highlight
9:30 / 13:00	Arrival at Yongqing Fang, Liwan District
9:30–10:15 / 13:00–13:45	Heritage walking tour – explore restored alleys and traditional Lingnan architecture
10:15–10:45 / 13:45–14:15	Cantonese Opera Museum – costumes, instruments, and stage history (live performance if available)
10:45–11:45 / 14:15–15:15	Hands-on heritage workshop – choose one craft
11:45–12:15 / 15:15–15:45	Local snack tasting (optional) – sample traditional Cantonese treats
12:15–12:30 / 15:45–16:00	Wrap-up and free time for photos

Visit Highlights

🏮 Heritage Walking Tour – More Than Just Old Buildings

What students see at Yongqing Fang:

- **79 preserved historic buildings** – including Qilou arcades, traditional courtyard houses, and the former residence of Bruce Lee's family
- **The "micro-renovation" approach** – how old structures were carefully restored, not rebuilt, following the principle of "repairing the old as old"
- **Everyday life** – local residents still live above the shops — this is a real neighbourhood, not a theme park

What they take away:

A real understanding of how cities can preserve heritage while adapting to modern needs.



Visit Highlights

🎭 Cantonese Opera Art Museum – A Deep Dive into Lingnan Performing Arts

What students experience:

- A Lingnan garden with pavilions, ponds, and a traditional theatre stage
- Exhibits on **Cantonese opera history, costumes, instruments**, and legendary performers
- If available – a live rehearsal or performance excerpt



Visit Highlights



Hands-On Heritage Workshops

Students choose one traditional craft — led by certified artisans. All materials provided. Take home what you make.

Sample crafts (subject to availability):

- Sachet making — blend herbs and fill a silk sachet
- Bamboo weaving — learn basic weaving techniques to create a small bamboo item
- Woodblock printing — arrange characters and print your own design
- Kingfisher feather craft (Diancui) — create a traditional brooch

Other crafts may be available upon request. Duration varies by craft.
